General Information

Eligibility: Your family must be a current member of HomeschoolNewYork/NYS LEAH, or a local LEAH Chapter at the time of registration. If not a current member, go to **www.leah.org** and **Join Now** or **Renew** before submitting your registration.

Where/When: The 2026 Commencement Ceremony will be held at The Smith Center for the Arts, Geneva, NY, on June 6, 2026 at 4:30 PM beginning with the graduate slideshow. Parents and graduates are required to attend the rehearsal tentatively scheduled for 1 PM on June 6th, at The Smith.

Ceremony: The ceremony is a stand-alone event and offers parents the opportunity to honor their high-school graduate by presenting him/her with their diploma on stage, while a verse (chosen by the graduate) and future plans are read. Blue caps/gowns must be worn for the ceremony.

Fee: The non-refundable fee of \$140 includes: a cap, gown, and tassel (all royal blue); a diploma with matting and a plastic sleeve, the cost of mailing your gown package to you; your personal listing in the program (provided it is received by the deadline); and a 5x7 group photo of the graduates. Partial packages are available. We will personalize your diploma if purchased as part of your package (required information must be supplied).

Late Registration Limitations: Gowns are ordered in early March, sizes may be limited after that. Personalized diploma, inclusion in the program and/or the slideshow may also be limited dependent on the completion of those portions of the ceremony. Registrations are non-refundable, so check with Megan Bomgren before registering late.

Graduate Slideshow Presentation: To be included in a slideshow presentation shown before the ceremony, provide 2-3 photos of the graduate (age birth-present suggested). Copies, or electronic photos are accepted. If you need them returned to you, include a self-addressed, stamped envelope large enough for your photos. If we do not receive a SASE, we will assume that you don't need the photos returned. Please note that by sending photos, you agree that we are not responsible for lost or damaged photos. Mail photos to the address for the registration form, or if electronic, send to: upstatecommencement@nysleah.org. The DEADLINE for ALL submissions is January 31st, 2026. Please label EACH photo with first and last name.

Guests/Seating: NO TICKETS ARE NEEDED. The Smith Center for the Arts has theater-style seating and includes a balcony. There are limited spaces for wheelchairs on the main level.

OPTIONS FOR 2026 Graduates

Graduate Photos: A photographer will be available for families who would like a professional photo of their graduate. Please see the order form on the last page for ordering information. Please note: the form and payment **should not** be sent with your registration. **It must be mailed to LRS IHMAGES** at the address on the photo form.

Shout-Outs: Shout-outs, or personal congratulations to your graduate, will be published in the Commencement program. The message must be appropriate and edifying. The commencement coordinator reserves the right to edit or refuse a shout-out if deemed inappropriate. Each shout-out will cost \$10.00 (non-refundable) for up to 20 words with any additional words \$.50 (50 cents) each. Multiple shout-outs can be purchased by writing them on a separate sheet of paper and including the additional amount.

T-Shirts: We are offering 2026 T-Shirts for both graduates and parents again this year. The silk-screened shirts have an attractive design with the text: HomeschoolNewYork Graduate 2026 and are available in male grad (w/ block text), female grad (w/script text and a heart) and parent (Proverbs 22:6, Proud Parent) designs. Each is available for \$25 and must be pre-ordered on the order form.

HomeschoolNewYork/NYS LEAH Board Guidelines for Commencement

To the graduates and their families:

The purpose of the Commencement Ceremony is to allow a special time to acknowledge the Lord's part in each family's homeschooling efforts, and to give Him glory, honor, praise and thanksgiving for guiding each family through their years of homeschooling.

In keeping with that purpose, we want to guard against anything which might disrupt this special time by establishing some guidelines which are designed to protect those who want to participate in a reverent time of acknowledging God's goodness.

Participation in the Commencement Ceremony is a privilege extended to member families, not a right of membership. The Board of Directors reserves the right to exclude from participation any member family if it is determined that their participation is not in the best interest of the organization, or of the reputation of Christian homeschooling.

We recognize that participation in contests, competitions, honors programs, etc., can provide powerful motivation in the pursuit of excellence and wholeheartedly congratulate the graduates on the achievement of any honors, awards, and trophies that they may have received. However, inasmuch as we have no control over, and makes no judgments with respect to, any particular awards and honors received by our graduates, the wearing of any honor garb, regalia, or other award insignia, in order to distinguish one graduate from another, is NOT permitted DURING the Commencement Ceremony or DURING the official group photograph. The graduate **may** include mention of any awards or honors received in their personal biographical material which is printed in the program and/or read during the awarding of diplomas. The graduate may also adorn themselves with their honor insignia immediately AFTER the ceremony if desired, and for any personal photographs, whether taken by the official photographer or by family and friends.

In our vigilance to uphold the honor and dignity of the occasion, we require the following standards for those graduates who wish to participate in the Commencement Ceremony.

Modesty and birth gender are the standards for both ladies and gentlemen and applies to both parents and graduates.

Ladies: Please wear a dress/skirt/top and dress shoes. Dress slacks are allowed but not preferred. Optional: jewelry and make-up.

Gentlemen: Please wear dress pants, dress shirt, tie, and dress shoes.

We urge each graduate and family to carefully consider how they present themselves: *Is it honoring to God? *Does it show love and respect to your Christian brothers and sisters who may hold to different dress or achievement standards? *Does it contribute to an atmosphere of dignity and honor?

The diploma presented by the parents is a personal choice and is not considered equivalent to a New York State issued diploma. The presenting of the diploma is not an endorsement by LEAH of completion of studies.
